

# Glorious Goldfish

This delightful little goldfish will make a perfect pet—all the fun with no special care required! The pattern is from Terra Parma's book, *Precious Pets*, published by Stained Glass Images. Besides our goldfish friend, this full-size pattern book also features lots of favorite pets including a cat, dog, frog, turtle parrot, rabbit, horse, and colt.

The variegated colors in the glass chosen for the background give the swirls in the water a realistic look, and careful glass selection for the fish, seaweed, and rocks add to the three-dimensional feel of the panel. Finishing touches, such as the eye of the goldfish, can be cut from glass or added with glass paint.


