Cats are natural-born explorers, and this curious kitty is no exception. The design is from Marianne Crivellaro's pattern book, *Christmas Cutties*, which is included in her twelve-book collection, *The Ultimate Pattern Book, Volume 3*. A selection of complementary colors for the hat box stripes plus careful attention to the placement of glass grain for the design elements help to give the cat's fur this free-form panel depth and realism. Finishing touches for the cat's face and paws can be added with black glass paint. You might think about using copper wire for the whiskers.

With a total of more than 300 full-size sun-catcher and small panel designs for beginning and intermediate glass artists and hobbyists, there is something for every taste. In addition to stained glass, the patterns would also make a good resource for mosaic and fused glass art as well. Besides *Christmas Cutties*, you'll also find *All Stars 2*, *Femmes Fatales*, *Secret Garden*, *Happy Holidays*, *E-I-E-I-O*, plus six additional complete pattern books. **GPQ**

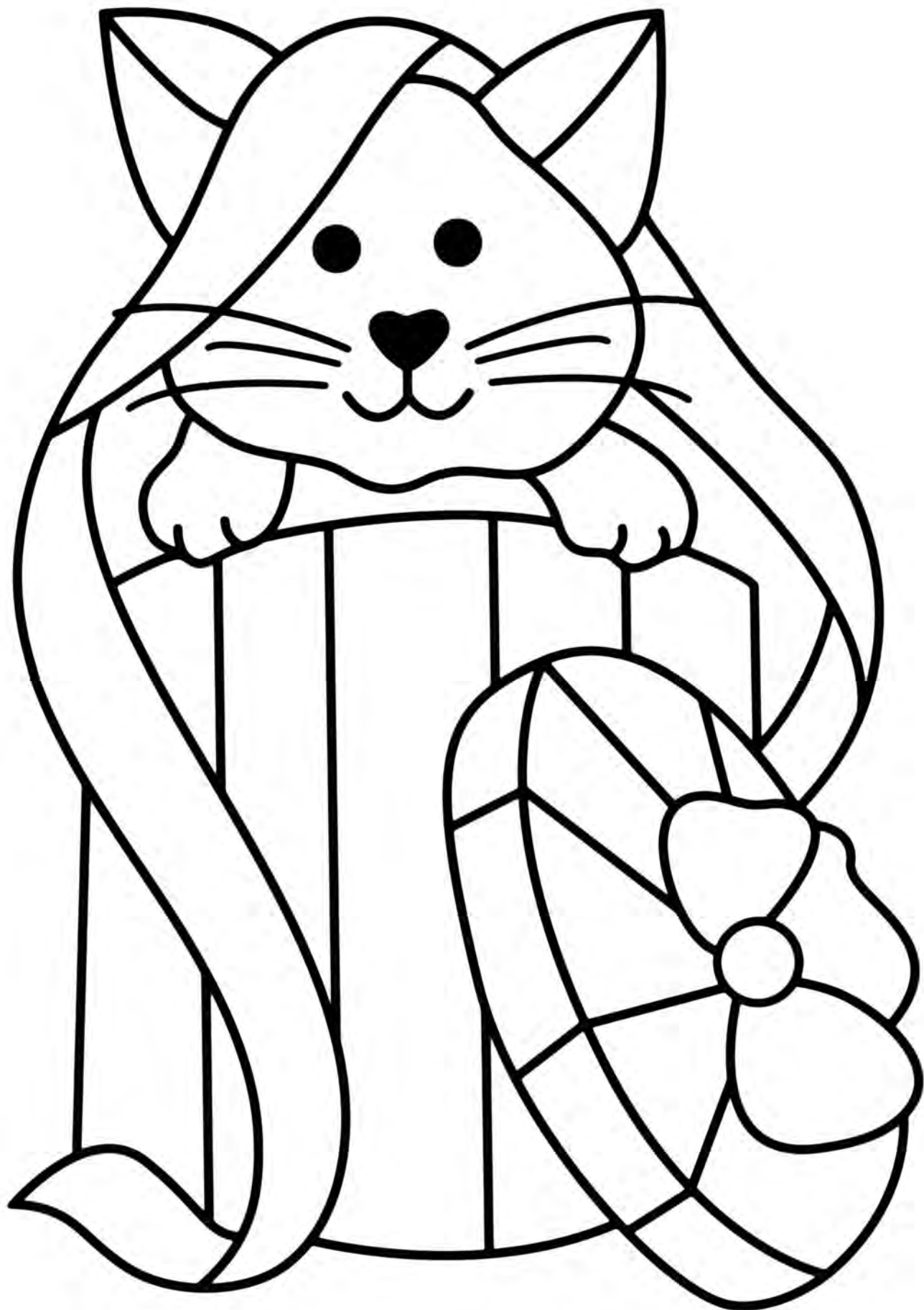
