

Smiling Flower and Ladybug

This perky posie looks happy with her ladybug friend, a welcome addition to gardens because these brightly colored beetles feed on lots of the plant-eating insects that can be found there. This stylized design from Marianne Crivellaro offers a chance for you to practice your glass painting skills to add details for the flower's face and the ladybug's black spots. Or if you prefer, you can create the spots from black glass or painted and patinated copper sheet foil. The legs and antennae for the ladybug can be made with copper wire.

This 8-1/4" x 9" panel comes from *Florals All Around*, one of the twelve full-size pattern books included in *The Ultimate Pattern Book, Volume 2* by Marianne. With more than 300 full-size suncatcher and small panel designs for beginning and intermediate glass artists and hobbyists, there is something for everyone. Besides *Florals All Around*, the collection also includes *Deck the Halls*, *Luck of the Irish*, *Paws*, *Easter Parade*, and *More Little Women*, plus six other complete pattern books. These patterns would also be a great resource for mosaic and fused glass artists.

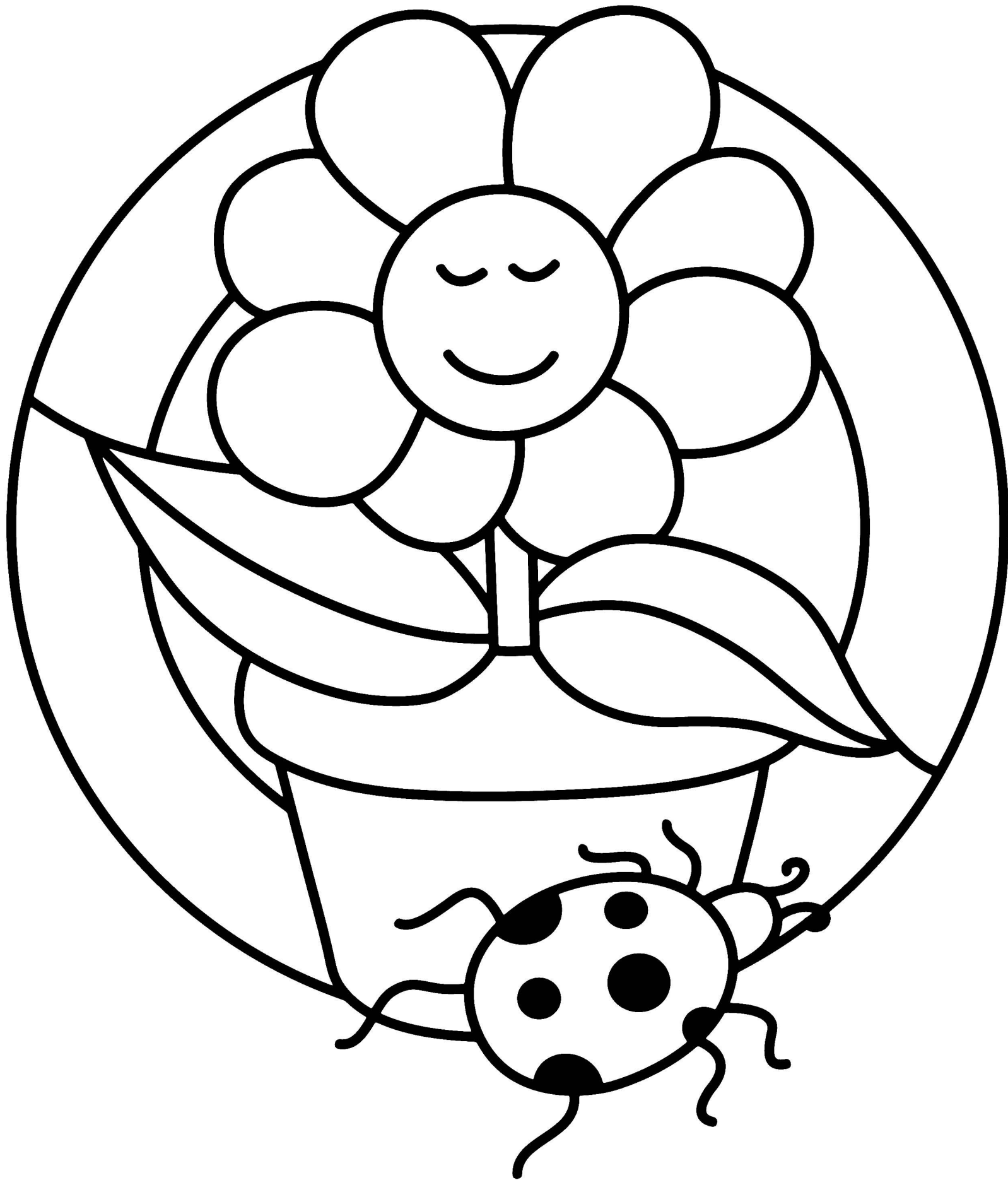
