Angels provide a favorite subject when creating in glass, especially at Christmastime. They offer a welcome addition to holiday decor or a treasured gift to those on your list of family and friends with whom you want to share a special part of yourself.

The luminous glow for the wings, hair, and dress is achieved through careful use of the glass colors and grains, which gives the appearance of light shining on the angel plus a feeling of depth and dimension to the piece. This 8" x 9-1/2" small panel is from Marianne Crivellaro's book, *Peace on Earth*, part of *The Ultimate Pattern Book, Vol. 1*. As in all three collections, Volume 1 contains twelve of Marianne's full-size pattern books. Besides *Peace on Earth*, you'll find *Going in Circles*, *Little Women*, *Heaven Sent*, *All Stars I*, and *Femmes Fatales*, plus six others. This wide selection of themes and patterns makes it easy to find just what you are looking for in the way of glass crafting ideas.
