

Candle Lantern

Whether you want to light your way or simply provide a stunning accent piece for your home decor, these lovely candle lantern kits from 1 Glass Impressions will make the perfect addition to your glass art collection. The solid mahogany finished base is 6" x 6" x 1/2" thick and has slots for four panels. There is also a center surface hole for a glass votive candleholder, ten different patterns, and step-by-step instructions. If you prefer to use panels that are ready to use, there are also sets of four fired glass panels in outdoor eagle scenes, angels and poems, or wolf designs that have been fired onto solid-white stained glass available from 1 Glass Impressions.

Step 1

Wrap the glass with 7/32" copper foil.




Step 2

Use a fid or lathkin to burnish the copper foil.



Step 3

Tack-solder the sides together.



Step 4

Run a finished solder bead on all of the seams.



Step 5

Use copper patina to finish all of the soldered seams.
